



Krash Industries Warranty Document

This policy applies to skis for purchased after 8st April 2019

Krash Industries' Ready to Perform performance PWC is designed for high-performance competition freestyle/freeride.

The 12-month warranty covers the following

- 1.1 All products inside the electronics box to be free from manufacturing or workmanship defects. This wholly includes the CDI, the stater relay, the regulator, the ignition coil, bullet connections, fuse and crimps.
- 1.2 All parts inside the motor, which have been unaffected by water ingestion or over heating, to be free from manufacturing or workmanship defects. This wholly includes the flywheel, Bendix, starter motor, pick up sensor, front cover stator, reeds, crank, conrods, pistons, domes. This excludes all consumables inside the motor such as gaskets, seals or sealants.

Any parts that are not specified in 1.1 and 1.2 are not covered by warranty.

You have the responsibility to get the unit to shore safely if something happens. If you have water ingestion you need to remove all water immediately, pickle your engine to avoid further damage and contact your dealer within 12 hours.

See pages 2 and 3 of the user guide for further water ingestion instructions.

If there is water ingestion of any kind, for whatever reason, or any alteration made to the fuel systems or engine dynamics such as changing the jetting or fuel flows, then any and all items in 1.1 and 1.2 may not fall under warranty.

If there is a potential warranty claim, it is the customer's responsibility to transport the unit in a safe, timely and appropriate manner back to the dealer for assessment. If the ski is brought not from a dealer, Krash Industries are to be contacted immediately and the unit will be transported back to a location of Krash Industries choosing, in a safe, timely and appropriate manner at the cost of the customer for the unit to be assessed.

The assessment of what is considered apart of the warranty and what is outside of the warranty is guided by 1.1, 1.2 of this document, and final decisions are ultimately upheld the dealer and Krash Industries.

Krash Industries' performance PWC have been developed with the enjoyment and performance at its core. The workmanship of Krash Industries PWC units are ever improving with every single engine manufactured going machining tests, compressions tests, dynamometer testing and water testing.
